LOC has a long history in the financial education of our young members through our student-run credit unions at local schools. This March we will be hosting an 8th Grade Financial Reality Fair for all 8th grade students at Parker Middle School.

A Financial Reality Fair is an interactive learning experience that allows students to simulate managing their own expenses for a month in the real world. Eighth grade students actively discover for themselves the choices that will affect their financial future as a part time employed high school student, they make decisions on expenditures while balancing their budgets. Students will choose from a bank of age appropriate part time jobs and will receive a budget worksheet. They then visit several stations to obtain the goods and services they would purchase, such as food, transportation including their first auto loan and planning for college. Students will end their fair experience with financial counseling to ensure they have properly balanced their budgets, as well as selected options that are financially fit.

Part of the success of these Financial Reality Fairs is due to the participation of parents and families of students as well as community members.
