Transportation

Students are responsible for their own transportation to/from Mt. Brighton each time they ski/board. There is no PA system on the hill, so either make arrangements for pickup ahead of time or text your student.

Student Behavior

This is a school- sponsored club; therefore all Howell Public School rules and code of conduct apply during skiing & boarding. If a student makes poor choices and does not follow the code of conduct for either Mt. Brighton or HPS, he/she will not be able to participate in HSBC outings. Our goal is to make this an enjoyable and safe club. Anyone failing to comply with the rules will be asked to leave. If a student is on probation or suspension with his/her school, he/she may be excluded from HSBC trips.

Responsibilities

A Club Sponsor will be in the Lodge from 3:30-4:30pm to hand out lift tickets, rental equipment vouchers, etc. and to check that anyone who signed up is accounted for. After that, students are free to ski and board on their own. The check in time is strict. Sponsors want to have fun with the kids outdoors, so please be on time or students may not be able to get their tickets. After 4:30pm club sponsors may be skiing and/or snowboarding.

Clothing

It gets cold on the mountain after the sun goes down, so dress in layers and always wear a windproof jacket and waterproof pants and a helmet. If you're unsure about buying specific outerwear, Summit Sports in Brighton is a great local resource. If you do bring extra clothing, use a locker to store your items.

Equipment

You are responsible for either bringing your own equipment, or renting your equipment. Don't leave your equipment unattended. A free ski/board corral is offered in the rental department. Use it if you don't want to lose your equipment. Mt. Brighton requires all skiers/boarders under age 18 to wear a helmet while on the hill. No exceptions.

Identification

Students should have their school ID on them when they are skiing with the club. If something happens while the student is on an HSBC outing, ski patrol will know who to contact if they see their student ID card. Media Centers at both schools can make replacement ID cards for \$5.00 if needed.

Leaving the Ski Area

Mt. Brighton is a large area and no one can keep track of all the students all the time. A sponsor is on the premises from 3:30-4:30 p.m. After that, students are expected to behave according to Howell Public School rules and code of conduct. Students are expected to follow the code of conduct for Mt. Brighton and that of Howell Public Schools.

Lessons

You may purchase a 1-hour group lesson any week that you are skiing; you will just RSVP by Sunday of that week that you would like a ski or a board lesson. We will have a calendar with sign up spots for each week and month of skiing. **If you're a first timer skier/boarder, we recommend you take a lesson.** You will have more fun and be safer on the hill. You will sign up and pay for lessons in advance and receive a voucher once you arrive at Mt. Brighton. Your student will check in at the HSBC table in the lodge, pick up his/her tickets and vouchers, then go to the group lesson meeting place on the bunny hill.

Lockers

Mt. Brighton has small lockers available in the lowest portion of the building behind their equipment rental. Lockers are \$5 or \$7 (depending on size) and the user creates a passcode which allows him/her to access the locker as many times as he/she wants. Mt. Brighton is not responsible for lost/missing items.

Weather

Winter can be fickle sometimes; if Mt. Brighton isn't open due to not enough snow to ski/board on a date your student is scheduled, you'll have a credit towards another date. If a date is cancelled due to an act of God, we will announce it by the end of the school day and try to post it on our school website. No refunds will be given for these dates

How the Whole Process Works

Once you complete the registration form and return it + payment for club fees + order form for the package you'd like to purchase, we will send home a "coupon booklet" that's basically a hard copy of what you paid for. Each week you will need to RSVP to your school's sponsor as to what you need for that week, e.g., lift ticket, rentals, lesson. You do not need to ski/board every week--we know kids are busy! Those reservations need to be emailed to your school's sponsor by Sunday of the week you want to ski/board. We send those reservations to Mt. Brighton and when we show up on Wednesday--our ski/board day-- we pick up the printed lift tickets and vouchers for everything else. When students check in at 3:30-4:30, they are given all the tickets & vouchers they reserved for that week. Lessons meet outside the ski school area at a specific time, which is printed on the voucher your student receives when he/she checks in.

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Fees

Below is a table of costs. You only have to purchase what you need. If you have your own equipment, then you would only need to purchase the Lift Tickets. Mt. Brighton requires all skiers/boarders under age 18 to wear a helmet. You must pre-pay and purchase your packages in advance and RSVP by the Sunday before for what you want. Mt. Brighton will have all our tickets, rental coupons and ski lessons set up in advance per your reservations.

Example: If you want to purchase a 3-week package of lift ticket + equipment rental it would be $\$90 + \$90 = \$180$. If you want to add just one lesson: $\$90 + \$90 + \$15 = \195 , Your student will get weekly tickets/vouchers for each item purchased.

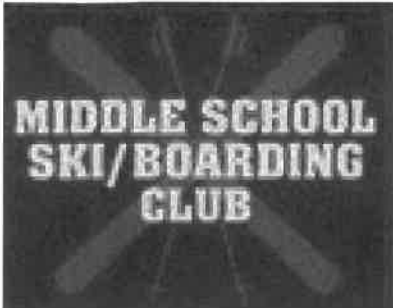

FITNESS FOR EVENT

I agree not to participate if, at the time of any event/activity, I know or have reasonable grounds to believe that I am not physically capable of participating in the event/activity. I will inform Howell Ski and Board Club of such physical issues prior to my participation in the event/activity, if applicable.

In consideration of and as inducement to Howell Ski and Board Club's acceptance of my child's participation in any and all events/activities involving the Howell Ski and Board Club, I expressly assume any and all risks of such damage or injury occurring to my child at any and all events/activities, and I hereby release and agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Howell Ski and Board Club and/or Howell Public Schools, and all their related entities, employees, directors, officers, members, volunteers, beneficiaries, venue hosts (including but not limited to Mt Brighton) and agents from any and all liability of any nature, causes of action, debts, claims, and demands of every kind and nature, whatsoever, for injury or damage, which I or any member of my family or any other person accompanying me to said events/activities may incur, or for which I may be liable, and which arises or is alleged to arise in connection with their participation in an event/activity involving the Howell Ski and Board Club and/or Howell Public Schools, whether occurring on the event grounds or the surrounding area thereto, or while traveling to or from such grounds or surrounding area. This release includes, but is not limited to, any claim for personal injury, property damage, wrongful death, and any and all fees and expenses related thereto whether the same shall arise by negligence, active or passive, or otherwise while my student engages in this event/activity involving the Howell Ski and Board Club and/or Howell Public Schools or which may accrue thereafter in connection with the event/activity involving the Howell Ski and Board Club and/or Howell Public Schools, or in connection with any activities which my student may conduct before or after the event/activity involving the Howell Ski and Board Club and/or Howell Public Schools.

I have read and understand this agreement, and am aware of the legal consequences of signing this agreement, regardless of where I live, where the agreement is signed or where the event/activity involving Howell Ski and Board Club takes place.
